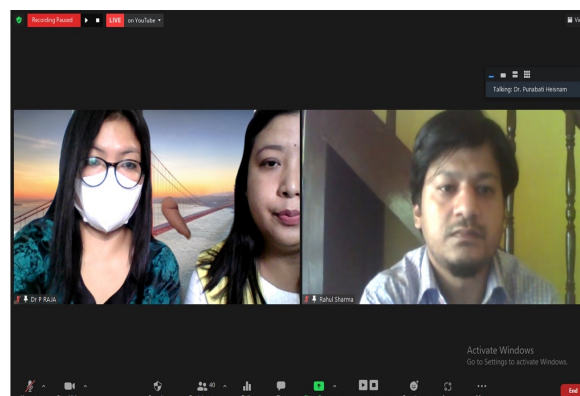

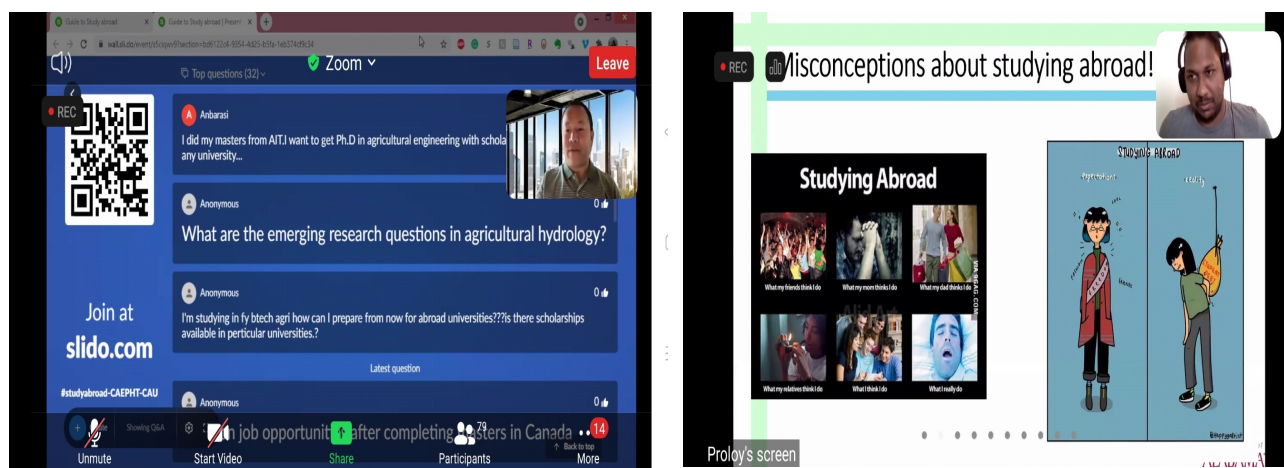


## Lecture Series on Aqua-Feed Industry at the College of Fisheries

The program – one of the first of its kind – was conducted under the aegis of IDP-NAHEP (ICAR and World Bank Project) by the Department of Aquaculture of the college in association with Society of Aquaculture Professionals (SAP), India for inculcating entrepreneurship in professional fisheries undergraduate and graduate students of the College. The lecture series consisted of a total of eight lectures by eight distinguished experts from a total of six prominent national and international aqua-feed companies covering all important aspects of aqua-feed industry in the country including the current status, recent developments, trends and challenges in feed formulation, development, processing, technological solutions and gadgets and marketing of Aqua-feed in India. In the last day of the lecture series, Dr. Angan Roy, National Sales Manager, Indian Herbs Specialties Pvt. Ltd. delivered an insightful lecture on **Functional Feeds & Sourcing of Bioactive Compounds** while Mr. Ramankanta Nayak, Chairman, Grobest Feeds (India) Pvt. 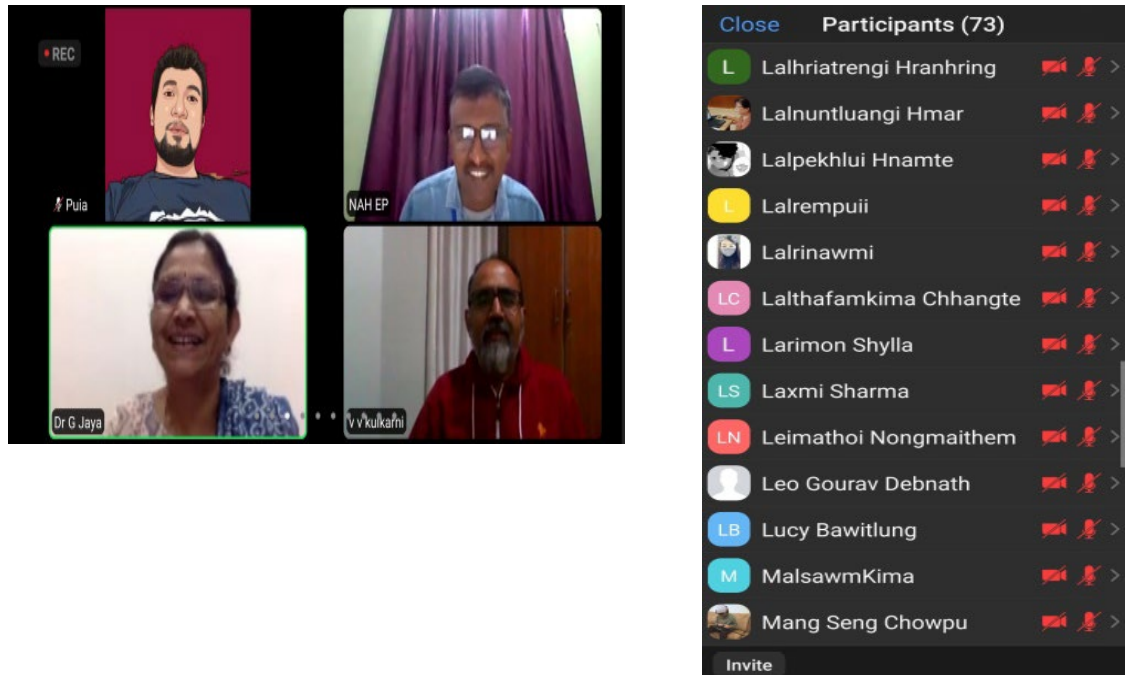

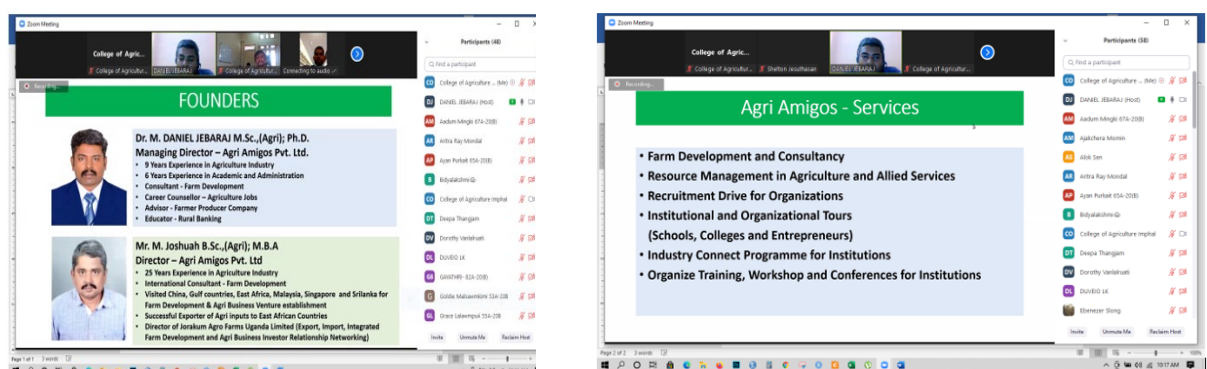

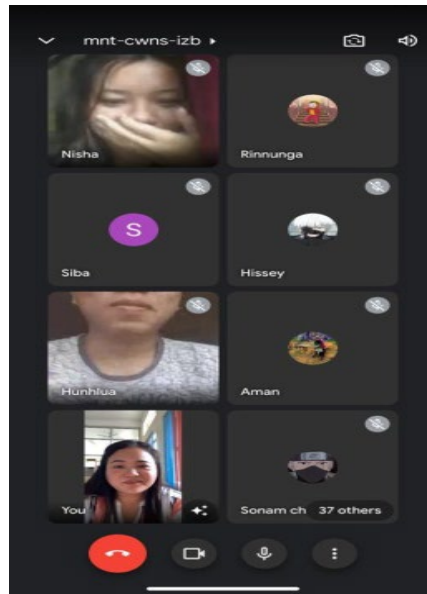
