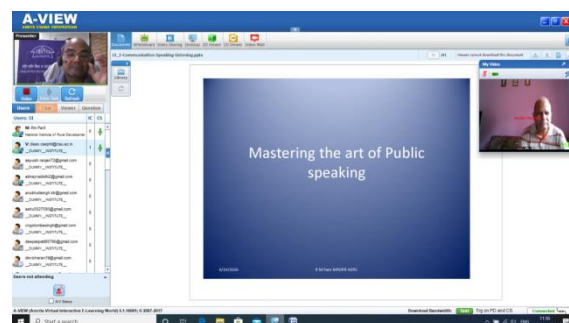
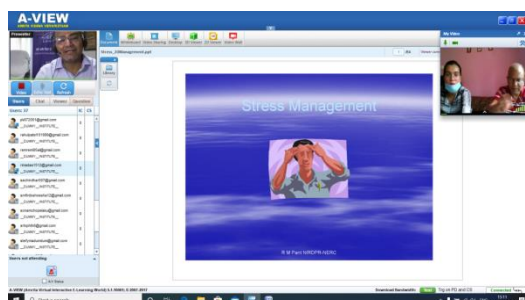
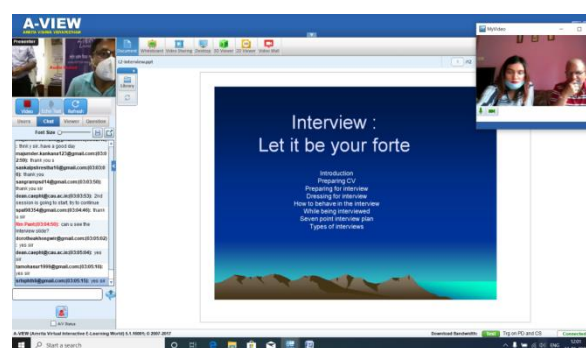
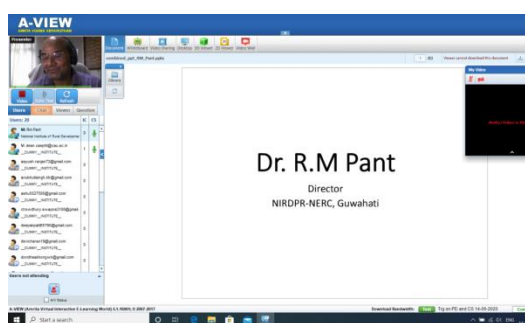


Photo: Two days online skill development workshop on “Personality Development and Communication Skill” under NAHEP-IDP, conducted at CAEPHT, Ranipool.

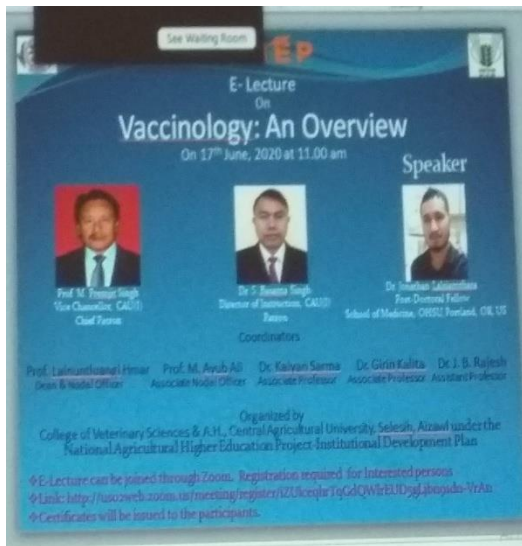


Photo: One day virtual training on “Vaccinology: an Overview” under NAHEP-IDP, College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Mizoram
