File No. VC/CAU/54/95-A(Vol-VI)/ 1434 : Central Agricultural University, Imphal (CAU) invites all the candidates who have applied for the post of Assistant Professor in various disciplines pertaining to **Advt. No. 02/2025 dated 8th August, 2025 and 04/2025 dated 7th November, 2025** to take note of the following important information regarding the Written Examination scheduled to be conducted by the University.

1. DISCIPLINES

The Written Examination shall be conducted separately for various disciplines as listed in **Annexure-I** attached herewith. Candidates are advised to carefully verify their respective discipline before appearing in the examination.

2. EXAMINATION PATTERN

The Written Examination shall be an Objective Type (Multiple Choice Questions – MCQ) test with the following scheme:

- Total Number of Questions: 50 (Fifty)
- Type: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) with four options
- Marks for Correct Answer: +2 (Two marks)
- Exam Duration: 2 Hrs.
- Negative Marking: There will be no negative marking.
- Unattempted Questions: No marks deducted
- Maximum Marks (Written Examination): 100

Candidates are advised to attempt questions with due care. OMR Sheet will be used for answer marking.

3. SYLLABUS

The syllabus for the Written Examination shall be based on the syllabus prescribed by the **Agricultural Scientists Recruitment Board (ASRB)** for the post of Scientist in the respective discipline. Candidates are advised to refer to the official ASRB syllabus available on the ASRB website (www.asrb.org.in) for preparation. The University shall not be responsible for any deviation in preparation arising out of reference to any other source.

4. QUALIFYING CRITERION

Only those candidates who secure a minimum of 50% of the total marks in the Written Examination (i.e., 50 out of 100 marks) shall be declared as qualified and shall be considered for further evaluation. Candidates failing to secure the minimum qualifying marks shall not be considered for any further process of selection.

5. FURTHER EVALUATION PROCESS

Candidates who qualify the Written Examination shall be subjected to a comprehensive further evaluation process. The overall selection shall be based on a total weightage of 100 marks as detailed below:


The marks obtained in the Written Examination shall be proportionately **scaled to a weightage of 60** marks for the purpose of final merit computation.

6. TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

The Written Examination is tentatively scheduled to be held in the Third/Fourth Week of June, 2026. The exact date, time, and venue for each discipline shall be communicated through the University's official website (www.cau.ac.in) and through individual admit cards. Candidates are advised to visit the website regularly for updates.

7. ADMIT CARD

Admit Cards will be made available well in advance and shall be shared to the email used in application form submission. No candidate shall be permitted to appear in the examination without a valid Admit Card along with a government-issued photo identity proof.
